Who is eligible?

You qualify for the LG&E or KU WeCare Program if you:

- Have been an active LG&E or KU customer for the past twelve months
and
- Meet the annual or monthly income guidelines

Proof of income will be required on the initial visit. Verification can be supplied through a paycheck stub, unemployment check, Aid for Dependent Children benefits, child support, disability, Social Security, pension, retirement income or a No-Income Affidavit.
